## Checking the GOES Wallups Connection

### I. Purpose:

To describe the procedure for connecting to the Wallups Island dial-up computer to check the GOES data.

### II. Cautions and Hazards:

### IV. Procedure:

#### A. Steps:

1. Set your communications parameters to 7 data bits, 1 stop bit and no parity.
2. BAUD rate can be set to 9600.
3. The phone number is 757-824-0105.
4. After the connection is made, hit enter and a screen requesting a username will appear.
5. Username=**bhnlab**
6. Password=**aaaaaa**
7. A '>' prompt will appear.
8. Type '**DI**' enter, all typing will appear as caps.
9. Type '**MESSAGE\_FILE**' enter.
10. Type '**PLATFORM\_ID**' enter.
11. Type '**1190567C ddd/hh**' enter. '**ddd**' = Julian date, '**hh**' = beginning hour of data to display in GMT.
12. The data will display, if there is more than one screen full type '**FOR**' to page through the data.
13. ESC key followed by an enter terminated the current command.
14. '**BYE**' logs off the remote system.
15. '**HELP**' gets a list of commands and you can get help on individual commands by entering '**HELP <command>**'.
