## Conversion of PAL Video to VHS (NTSC) Video

### I. Purpose:

To describe the procedure to convert a PAL video to a VHS (NTSC) video.

### III. Requirements:

### IV. Procedure:

#### A. Steps:

1. Unplug PAL VCR from TV.
2. Make sure that VCR cable is connected to the PAL VCR output connections **IN THE BACK** of the PAL VCR.
3. Hook up the other end of the VCR cable to the input connections in the back of the VHS VCR.
4. On the PAL VCR (Panasonic AG-W1) make sure that the **PAL** button is selected, **EDIT** is **ON**, and **Input Select** is on **Line 2**.
5. Make sure the PAL tape is fully re-wound or at the point recording should begin.
6. Place both tapes in respective VCRs.
7. Press **RECORD** on the VHS (NTSC) VCR and **PLAY** on PAL VCR simultaneously. If it is not possible to press them both simultaneously, press record and then play.
8. Let the VCRs run until recording is complete.

#### NOTE:

When hooking the PAL VCR back to the TV, remember to switch **EDIT** to **OFF** and **Input Select** to **LINE 1**.
